

# PRIVATE & SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS

Thank you for choosing Grouse Mountain as the resort where you learn to ski or snowboard. Included in this letter is important information regarding your program, **please take the time to read it carefully.** 

\*\*Guests with their own equipment should board the Skyride at least 1 hour prior to their lesson start time. \*\*Guests renting equipment should board the Skyride at least 1.5 - 2 hours prior to their lesson start time and then proceed to the Outpost Rental Shop at the top of the mountain to be fitted into their gear.

# Meeting Area

Please be at the Snow School Meeting Place, located just outside the doors of the Outpost Rental Shop, 15 minutes prior to the lesson time in preparation for meeting the instructor.

#### Tickets (Child/Escort)

If the student is under the age of 13 we have enclosed a complimentary escort ticket for each lesson booked.

# What to Wear

Helmets are mandatory for <u>all</u> children taking lessons. If your child has their own equipment but requires a helmet, you can rent one for an additional \$5 plus tax at the time of registration. Helmets can also be purchased at Outfitters in the Chalet, where Passholders receive a 20% discount on their purchase. As mountain conditions can change rapidly, please dress your child in layers and waterproof clothing. We also suggest bringing along extra mittens/gloves and socks. Eyewear is strongly recommended.

#### **Rental Information**

If rental equipment is required, please proceed to the Outpost Rental Shop 1 hour **BEFORE** your lesson start time.

#### Day of Lesson
